## Course Selection for 2020-2021

#### Information for YRDSB School Students not living within KCSS Boundaries

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Thank you for choosing King City Secondary School (KCSS).

### **Registration Process:**

- Students must first complete and submit a **Registration Form** along with a **Transfer Form** to their **home** secondary school by January 31<sup>st</sup> 2020.
- Families will be notified of their acceptance in February after the regional transfer meeting. At this time students will be able to select their **courses on 'My Pathway Planner'** for King City Secondary School.
- **Course selections** (printed and signed) are due to their grade 8 teacher by **February 24<sup>th</sup>**, **2020**. You may also choose to bring the course selections directly to KCSS guidance department if you prefer.
- Course Verifications will be sent out in early spring and should be returned to King City SS only if changes are needed.

In order to facilitate this process we have prepared a registration package that contains the following:

#### **Registration Package**

- 1. York Region District School Board (YRDSB) Secondary Student **Registration Form** (due to home secondary school by January 31<sup>st,</sup> 2020)
- 2. Transfer Form (due to home secondary school by January 31<sup>st,</sup> 2020)
- 3. Grade 9 Courses offered at KCSS (for reference, courses are selected on My Pathway Planner)
- **4. What Course Type do I Choose?** How do I choose between Academic, Applied and Locally Developed Courses?
- 5. Grade 9 Electives What Discipline are they in?
- 6. King City Secondary School Course Offerings 2019-2020
- 7. What Do I Need to Graduate?
- Please use the information in the registration package to help guide your course selections.
- Remember to discuss course selections with your current grade 8 teacher in order to obtain their input as to the most suitable course types for grade 9.
- Please take the time to fill out the course selections accurately, as it may be difficult to make changes later.
