The school year begins on **Tuesday, September 4, 2018.** Students are asked to be on the school property beginning at 8:20 a.m. Please be advised that our soft entry starts at 8:20, classes start at 8:35 sharp, our **lunch hour will remain to be 12:15 – 1:15 and the scheduled end time is 2:55 p.m. for all grades**. For the first day please ensure that your child brings a lunch or a lunch will be dropped off. Please plan drop off and pick up times accordingly.

As we wrap up this school year, we are busy planning a successful start for September 2018. We are working with a tentative organization and tentative class/teacher placements. We will be notifying you by email during the last week of August regarding your child's tentative homeroom assignment and teacher. If your email has changed, please notify the office immediately with your new email address. This email will be sent out at the end of August notifying you of the class placement of your child (example - 1A, or 4/5A, etc.). On the first day of school, our grade 1 to 8 teachers will greet students at the rear of the school where there will be class signs displaying each homeroom. Students will line up at their appropriate class sign and then students will be taken to their classroom. Class lists will not be posted. Our K2 (senior kindergarten) students will be contacted in late August as they will have a staggered school year start. At this point all of our hiring has not yet been completed; teacher's names cannot be shared. Kindly remember that all KPS teachers hold an Ontario College of Teachers certificate and are qualified to teach in the division and/or grade assigned. Please note that as per Ministry guidelines class/school reorganization takes place at the end of September once our enrollment is finalized, please

understand there will be no changes made before then.
