

Kleinburg Public School Dress Code Policy

APPROPRIATE DRESS FOR A SAFE AND RESPECTFUL LEARNING AND TEACHING ENVIRONMENT

- No spaghetti straps (must be at least 2 fingers wide)
- No see through clothing materials
- Midriff area and back covered completely
- No headgear, including hoodies, to be worn inside school (except for religious reasons)
- All cleavage concealed
- All undergarments hidden from view
- No pajamas or clothing that looks like pajamas
- Clothing free of inappropriate logos, slogans, phrases, and pictures

Any attire deemed unacceptable by the principal is not permitted.

The school dress code assists in the creation of a positive learning environment. Inappropriate dress distracts and diverts us from our primary purpose LEARNING!

Administration will make final decisions regarding appropriate dress. Students may be sent home to change or provided with alternate clothing to meet the expectations of the dress code.

Non-compliance

Students who choose to wear clothing that does not conform to the code may be asked to:

- Turn the piece of clothing inside out;
- Wear something over the offending piece of clothing;
- Change into something else, remove the accessory;
- Give the offending item to the teacher or principal or;
- Possibly go home to change.

Consequences for serious non-compliance shall be consistent with the YRDSB Safe Schools Policy and Procedure.

- Very short skirts/shorts
