School and Student Property

Damage to Property

We expect students to respect their own, their friends' and school property. Students will be held responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of school property that they vandalize.

Cell Phones, Pagers and Other Electronic Devices

Cell phones, pagers and other personal communications devices are to be turned off and kept out of sight during all instructional periods, except with the explicit permission of the classroom teacher. Infractions will be dealt with as student discipline, under the Board's Safe, Caring and Supportive Schools Policy. Cell phone camera functions are not permitted to be used on school property without explicit permission from the principal or designate.

The school is not responsible for personal items that go missing at the school.

Bicycles/Skateboards/Baseball Bats/Roller Blades

Students who are permitted to ride their bicycles or use rollerblades to travel to school during good weather should note the following:

- 1. Wear helmets while riding bikes or while rollerblading.
- 2. Bicycles must be walked on school property.
- 3. Bicycles should be stored and locked on the bicycle rack.
- 4. The school will not be held responsible for any lost or damaged bikes or rollerblades.
- 5. Rollerblades are to be removed when students arrive on school property.
- 6. Skateboards, baseball bats and Healey's are not allowed on school property.
