

Lakeside Public School Dress Code

All students:

- Must wear a top and bottom layer of clothing of opaque (not see through ie. sheer or net) material.
- May wear tops that expose arms, shoulders, stomachs, midriffs, neck lines, and straps but must cover any areas normally covered by private undergarments.
- May wear bottoms that expose legs, thighs and hips but must cover any areas normally covered by regular sized underwear.
- May not wear private undergarments as outerwear.
- May wear any headwear that does not obscure or partially cover the face. Hoods are considered to obscure or partially cover the face.
- May wear dress requirements to support creed practices and similar human rights accommodations.
- May not wear anything that promotes or symbolizes drugs, alcohol, illegal activity, hate or discrimination, profanity/swearing, pornography; or that incites violence or harassment; or threatens health and safety.

Consequences if the dress code expectations are not followed:

1. The student will be reminded of the dress code and will be asked to change or cover up the item of clothing that does not follow the dress code.
2. If a student is unable to change or cover up, or refuses to do so, they will be sent home for the remainder of the day.
3. If a student continues to not follow the dress code expectations, and/or their is a pattern of behaviour that demonstrates a refusal to follow the dress code, this may result in a suspension.
