September 17, 2018**



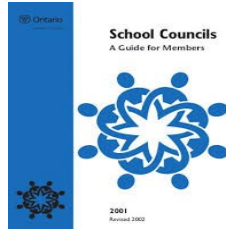
All meetings will begin at 7:00 and will be held in the Lakeside Library.
