Lakeside Public School Dress Code All students:

- Must wear a top and bottom layer of clothing of opaque (not see through ie. sheer or net) material.
- May wear tops that expose arms, shoulders, stomachs, midriffs, neck lines, and straps but must cover any areas normally covered by private undergarments.
- May wear bottoms that expose legs, thighs and hips but must cover any areas normally covered by regular sized underwear.
- May not wear private undergarments as outerwear.
- May wear any headwear that does not obscure or partially cover the face. Hoods are considered to obscure or partially cover the face.
- May wear dress requirements to support creed practices and similar human rights accommodations.
- May not wear anything that promotes or symbolizes drugs, alcohol, illegal activity, hate or discrimination, profanity/swearing, pornography; or that incites violence or harassment; or threatens health and safety.

Consequences if the dress code expectations are not followed:

- 1. The student will be reminded of the dress code and will be asked to change or cover up the item of clothing that does not follow the dress code.
- 2. If a student is unable to change or cover up, or refuses to do so, they will be sent home for the remainder of the day.
- 3. If a student continues to not follow the dress code expectations, and/or their is a pattern of behaviour that demonstrates a refusal to follow the dress code, this may result in a suspension.
