#### Parent representatives:

Participate on any committees established by the School Council Contribute to the discussions of School Council

Observe the Council's code of ethics and established by-laws

### Secretary:

Take minutes at each meeting (brief, clear summary of what was discussed, at the meeting including decisions, future plans, reports, and who is responsible for what; the minutes should also include a list of those attending)

Send minutes out to members of the School Council via email

#### Treasurer:

Obtain the Budget Report from the office prior to each Council meeting

Share deposits and expenditures with Council at each meeting Count and organize money from fundraisers in the Principal's office and prepare the bank deposit (if applicable)

15 Principal's Update:

Fantastic start to the school year

Wonderful, supportive staff team

School enrolment has decreased

Caring and Safe Schools presentations

- Spirit wear: staff is discussing whether or not Spirit wear will be redesigned this year. Following calendar year is 25th anniversary of the school, there may be an opportunity for an anniversary release of Spirit wear.
- 17 Year books: due to privacy guidelines, year books must be put together by staff (not parent volunteers). If a staff members is able to take on this project, School Council will be informed.
- Hot lunches are being organized for 5 days a week. Lunchbox platform will be up and running in a few weeks. Updates to follow.
- Julie Pesonen volunteered to serve as a hot lunch volunteer coordinator. Additional parent volunteers are needed to fill 5 days a week plus at least one back up. Commitment is from 11:40am to 12:40pm.

Additional volunteers needed, reach out to Julie

- 20 Profits from hot lunch go to School Council. Program typically generates \$500-\$700 monthly profit. School Council will vote on where funding will be directed. Staff surveys are conducted to identify school needs. Previously funds were directed towards classroom technology, gym equipment, music program, standing desks.
- Paint lines in the school yard as well as basketball net may need to be repaired / replaced this year. Paving is not planned in the foreseeable future, this may be a good year to proceed with outdoor work.
