NAC1OF - French Immersion This course examines First Nations, Métis and Inuit cultures in Canada through an exploration of art forms - painting, sculpture, storytelling, dance, and music - created by Indigenous artists. Students will learn to identify indigenous art forms and describe relationships between the art forms and traditions, philosophy and culture. Students will be exposed to a broad range of disciplines including drawing, painting, sculptures, printmaking, photography and graphic design. Our talented teacher artists appreciate the various skills students may or may have have upon entering this course and teach with the individual in mind.

This course meets the Compulsory Art Requirement for the OSSD.
