Progress Reports

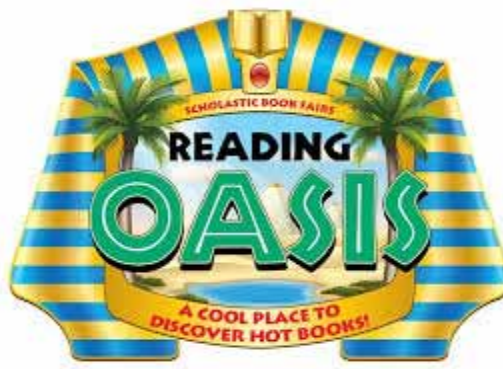
