Health and Safety







Dear Parents and Guardians,

Last December, the Government of Ontario announced funding to support elementary schools to lock their front doors during the school day.

All elementary schools are being equipped with front door cameras, monitors, intercoms and buzzer locking systems.

Beginning **Monday, February 3, 2014**, elementary school doors will be locked 15 minutes after the school bell rings in the morning and will stay locked for the remainder of the school day. All visitors, including parents/guardians will be required to use the buzzer at the front door and to sign in at the main office.

Our schools are safe places and safety continues to be our top priority. We have a number of safety measures already in place. Locking doors during the school day is one additional step the Board is taking to support student and staff safety.

Our schools will continue to be welcoming and inclusive places where parents and community members have an important role to play as a vital part of the school community.

We understand that you may have questions, and more information will be made available to you in the coming weeks.

If you have any questions or concerns, I encourage you to speak with your school principal.
