

#### Coming to Legacy March 31st.

We are very excited to welcome Canadian author, Eric Walters to our school on Monday March 31st.

He is a well-known author who has written many children and teen books. He will be meeting and talking to all the Junior and Intermediate classes with a lively, interactive and curriculum-linked presentation.

We are asking that all students in Grades 4 - 8 <u>bring a TOONIE</u> to help cover the cost of this wonderful opportunity. Classroom teachers will be collecting the money over the next week.

Eric will have several books with him available for the students to purchase. Unfortunately because he has written so many books we cannot guarantee what titles he will be bringing. Books range in price from \$7.00 to \$20.00. Eric will sign any books he sells that day . If there is time, he will also sign any personal books that students bring in.

We are also very excited to announce that ten lucky students will win the opportunity to have lunch with Eric Walters. Students may pick up a ballot in the library and complete the skill testing questions. All ballots must be brought back to the library and placed in the ballot box by Wednesday, March 27th.

#### Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child has been participating in Legacy's first Sport Stacking Club! The students will be practicing over the next few months in preparation for a school level tournament to be held on:

**Saturday, May** 3<sup>rd</sup> **at Bur Oak High School in Markham**. Parents are responsible for getting their children to & from tournaments as well as supervising outside of the competition area and cheering! There will be 10 schools competing that day (*Primary in the morning, Junior/Intermediate in the afternoon*). Students will compete individually and either in a relay with 3 others or a doubles event. They will demonstrate their skills in front of a judge who will record their timings for 3 attempts.

There will also be a Finals Championship on Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> in Markham, to determine the overall champions in York Region. Please note this date in the event that your child qualifies.

The cost of the school level tournament is \$35.00 per participant which covers costs such as registration fees, permit, team t-shirt and a minimum of one medal.

You can pay in cash or by cheque ~ no later than Monday, March 24th.

There is a separate category for the Parent and Child to compete together. Your child will teach you the 3-6-3 (Primary) or the Cycle (Junior/Intermediate). *Cost for the extra event is \$10.* 

You will receive a schedule for the day at a later date.
