
Milne Outdoor Education Centre

Every year our grade 2, 4 and 7 students have the opportunity to visit one of the York Region District School Board's Outdoor Education sites. This year our students are visiting Milne.

The Milne Outdoor Education Centre is located at Roy H. Crosby Public School and is ideally situated on the doorstep of the Milne Dam Conservation Park in the Town of Markham. Established in 1990, Milne is one of four centres that provide outdoor education for elementary schools in the York Region District School Board. While visiting Milne Outdoor Education Centre, students will explore a 120 hectare urban wilderness that contains a remarkable diversity of plants and animals. The Rouge River bisects the park from east to west and represents Milne's most significant natural feature. Milne's hands-on educational programs are connected to expectations of the Ontario Curriculum and provide students with the opportunity to learn in outdoor settings.
