# Crêpes:

Makes 12-15 crêpes:

# Ingredients:

1 cup flour

1 cup milk

3 large eggs

3 tbsp. Unsalted butter, melted

Pinch of Kosher salt

### Directions:

Place the flour in a bowl and combine with salt. Make a well in flour mixture. With a wire whisk, whisk 3 tbsp. butter, eggs and milk together and pour into flour well and combine until smooth - batter should be the consistency of heavy cream. Allow batter to rest for at least 1 hour in fridge (resting batter allows bubbles to settle down; this helps prevent crepes from tearing when cooking). Batter can be kept up to 2 days in fridge.

Heat a non-stick frying pan over medium high heat till hot. Spray with a non stick spray or coat with neutral tasting vegetable oil such as canola or safflower. Using a ladle pour about 2 tbsp. of batter into centre of pan. Rotate quickly till pan is evenly covered with batter. Cook until bubbles form on top about 30 seconds, flip with a spatula and cook for about 10 seconds on the other side. Place on a platter to keep warm and repeat for remaining crêpes. Makes around 12-15 crêpes.




