Tamil Heritage Month 2015 Poster Competition Details

Background:

Tamils began migrating to Ontario as early as the 1940s. Since then Tamil Canadians have overcome tremendous obstacles and have made significant contributions to the growth and prosperity of Ontario. For Tamil Canadians the Tamil Harvest Festival, Thai Pongal, as well as other Tamil artistic and cultural events takes place in January. **Thai Pongal** is celebrated on the first day of the month **Thai** of the Tamil calendar. This year, the **Thai Pongal Day** is celebrated on **Wednesday**, **January 14**, **2015** by Tamils in Canada and around the world.

By proclaiming the month of January as Tamil Heritage Month, the Province of Ontario recognizes the valuable contributions that Tamil Canadians have made to Ontario's social, economic, political and cultural fabric. Tamil Heritage Month is an opportunity to remember, celebrate and educate future generations about the inspirational role that Tamil Canadians have played and continue to play in communities across Ontario. This poster competition is one of the activities that are designed to engage students in York Region to learn about the rich heritage of Tamil Canadians.

Poster Competition Guidelines:

<u>Theme for 2015</u>: Develop a poster which focuses on individuals who contributed to the growth of Tamil heritage including social change, music, language, arts, science, math, equity and well being of others across the diaspora.

Submissions:

- Include a completed Entry Form with each format see Entry Form below.
- A Brief Description of the Depicted Subject Matter
- Entries must be received no later than Saturday February 13th, 2015.
- Open to all York Region District School Board Students, Grades 3 12.
- One entry per student.
- The artist's name must appear *only* on the Entry Form and <u>not</u> on the poster itself.

Submission Format:

- Posters can be hand drawn
- Digital format; in JPEG. & PDF. File.
- Participants can create work on paper or canvass and scan it into a JPEG file
