Learning Disabilities Symposium

Our students and families have expressed great interest in "diving deeper" and learning more about Learning Disabilities and Special Education in our schools. As a result of many wonderful and positive dialogues, the *Equity and Inclusivity Team* is making a commitment to providing parents and students with several opportunities to attend workshops and information sessions that will include a wide range of topics linked to Special Education. This month we have had the opportunity to invite **Matthew Cote** and **Rashmee Karnad-Jani** and her students as our guest speakers.

Dear families and students, my name is Matthew Cote and I am 18 years old with a learning disability. During the course of the summer, I will be a Tutor in the classroom. I have spent the last two summers working with Autism Ontario at the Summer Camp as a counselor. I just completed my first year at Trent University something that I have worked very hard to achieve during my grade twelve year in high school. I was really excited to be asked to speak at Legacy Public School and to be able to share my experiences with families and students. I aspire to be a teacher in the York Region District School Board and to be able to inspire students to achieve their best.

Rashmee Karnad-Jani began her work with LDAYR (Learning Disability Association of York Region) as a volunteer tutor in 2002. She is currently a teacher at Cedarwood PS in the YRDSB and teaches students with Learning Disability (LD), Mild Intellectual Disability (MID) and Autism. She is a strong Social Justice advocate and works with students and communities to support understanding of LD as well as making support available for students. Rashmee has published a book and two anthologies of poems and short stories, a book of poems written by her students as well is working towards completion of her Master's Thesis from York University. She has a degree in Biology from the University of Mumbai and a Bachelor of Education from York University. She also has specialist qualification in literacy for adolescents and special education.
