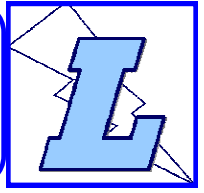

Grade 8 Trip to Ottawa






