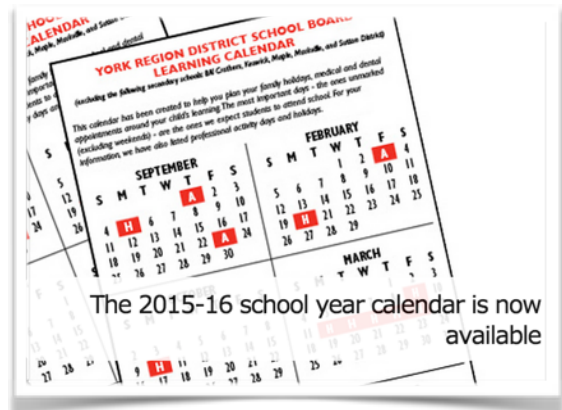
# LEGACY eBulletin

## School Safety

The Board has a number of policies and procedures in place to address emergency situations when normal school operations cannot continue or where student and staff member safety may be at risk. This could include a fire, flood or acts of violence. All schools have individual plans and conduct drills throughout the year. There will be six fire, two lockdown and one hold and secure drill throughout the year so students become familiar with Emergency Preparedness procedures. These drills are important so that in the case of an actual emergency, students and staff members know what to do to be safe. In a hold and secure situation, York Regional Police will ask that outside doors of a school be locked. Normal school operations will continue inside the building, but no one many enter or leave the building until police indicate it is safe to do so.
