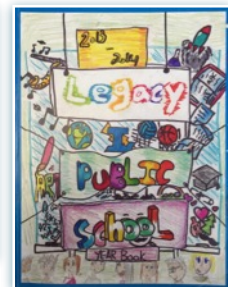

Vaisakhi is the most important holy day of the year for Sikhs and is celebrated in April of every year. Legacy is collecting used books for our Earth Friendly BOOK SWAP. It is as easy as **1, 2, 3.**



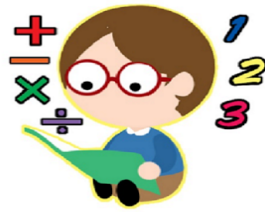
1. Bring in any books in good condition that you no longer need between Monday, April 11th and Fri. April 15th. Get a ticket for every book you bring in.

All extra books will be donated to a community that is in need of books for their schools.

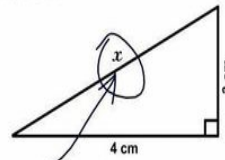
