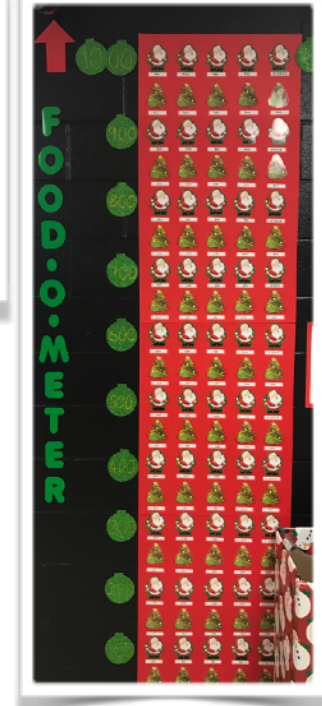
Legacy Food Drive

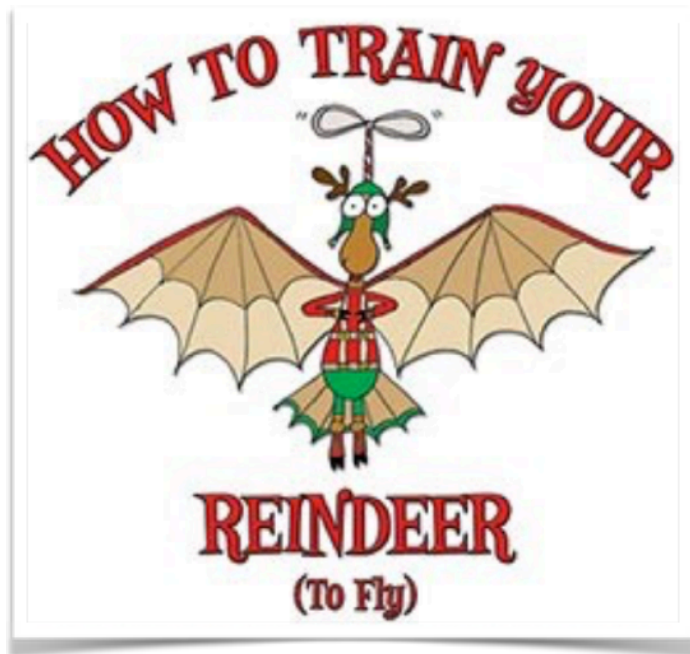
