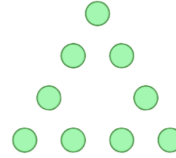

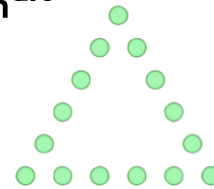

This triangle has 4 dots on each side. A total of 9 dots were used to make the triangle.



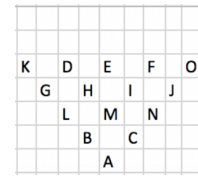
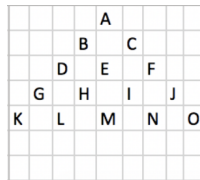
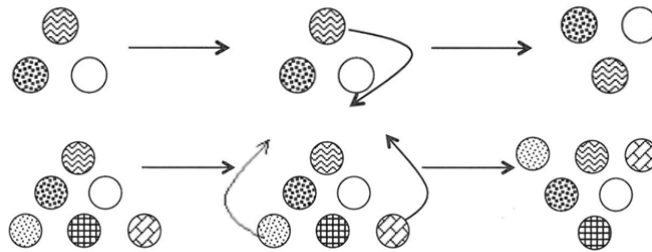
The bottom triangle has 6 dots on each side. A total of 15 dots were used to make the triangle.
