2018-2019 The Kids Plus™ Accident Insurance school distribution program has moved online!

All schools can now access <u>kidsplus.ca/resources</u> for information about Kids Plus™ which they can use on their respective websites, e-newsletters and social media. The main website at <u>kidsplus.ca</u> will continue to be available for parents to purchase coverage, access claims forms and full plan information online. Additionally, for 2018 Kids Plus™ decided to take their mission to be green one step further by discontinuing distribution of all Kids Plus™ Notices (Brochures) to reduce the overall paper use.

Please note that effective this September 1st, there will also be some changes to the Kids Plus[™] Accident Insurance policy that will impact the Active Plan holders. Permanent Total Disability coverage will be reduced from \$360,000 to \$100,000 and Dismemberment or Total & Permanent Loss of Use from \$200,000 to \$100,000. These changes were made in order to allow Kids Plus[™] to continue to offer the benefits families use most, such as dental treatment and eyewear, with no increase in premiums.

NO PARKING ZONES

RUSSELL JARVIS DR – THERE IS NO PARKING OR STOPPING IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL BETWEEN 8:30-9:30AM AND 3:00-4:00PM MONDAY-FRIDAY

BUS/FIRE ROUTE – PARKING OR STOPPING WILL RESULT IN A \$200 FINE ANY TIME OF DAY

PARKING LOT – THERE IS NO PARKING IN THE LOT ADJACENT TO THE SCHOOL AT ANY TIME (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ACCESSIBILITY PARKING); THIS LOT IS FOR THE USE OF STAFF ONLY

KISS'N'RIDE

BE PATIENT – TO AVOID POTENTIAL ACCIDENTS, DO NOT PASS OTHER VEHICLES IN THE PARKING LOOP

RIGHT SIDE EXIT – TO AVOID INJURY, CHILDREN MUST EXIT ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE ONTO THE SCHOOL PATHWAY

NO TRUNK/HATCH ACCESS – TO ENSURE EXPEDIENCY; PLEASE HAVE ALL REQUIRED ITEMS READILY ACCESSIBLE WHEN DROPPING OFF

USE CAUTION – WHEN LEAVING THE KISS'N'RIDE PROCEED SLOWLY BEFORE MERGING ONTO ROUGE BANK DR. CHILDREN WHO WALK/BIKE TO SCHOOL MAY NOT BE VISIBLE BEHIND THE BRICK HALF-WALL BEYOND THE STOP SIGN
