X Movement will be working with students and our families next week. On Wednesday night we welcome all of our families to join into a night of X Fusion Movement and Mindfulness.

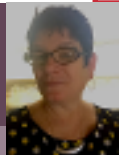
When: Sessions will run every 30 minutes.
