TECH UPDATE

Overhead LCD projectors have been installed in all classrooms in the school!! We are very excited about this update so that we are able to use technology in classrooms without the safety hazards of hanging cords and moving carts!!

The technology that was purchased in partnership with our School Council through the YRDSB Cost Sharing program has started to arrive!! As part of the Board's Cost Sharing Program, we were able to purchase 30 new Chromebooks (10 of which were bought by the LSC, 5 by the school which were matched by the YRDSB for a total of 30!!). Our Tech Team is quickly getting all security and software put onto the devices so that they will be in the hands of our students as soon as possible!!

A few reminders for parents to support the safety, comfort and health of children when they are at school.
