#### Kindergarten Registration Starts January 17, 2020

Kindergarten registration begins Friday, January 17 for the 2020-21 school year. We look forward to welcoming our new students and families to our school.

Children who turn four or five years old during 2020, live within the school boundary and whose parents/guardians are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register.

Learning about Thai Pongal

The festival's most significant practice is the preparation of the traditional "pongal" dish. It utilizes freshly harvested rice, and is prepared by boiling it in milk and raw cane sugar. Sometimes additional ingredients are added to the sweet dish, such as raisins, cardamom, coconut and cashew nuts. Pongal is cooked in clay pots on stoves similar to the picture below.
