Students will meet their next year's teachers and classmates on Wednesday, June 26th. They will participate in a few "get to know you" activities with their new classes.

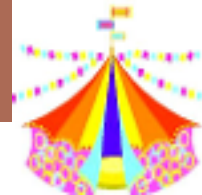
LAST E-BULLETIN
