#### **HOT WEATHER**



During hot, humid weather, our school office tracks temperatures and humidex levels hourly. If the temperature combined with humidity is above 35 degrees Celcius we will ensure the following:

- allow students to have frequent access to water
- ensure all classrooms have fans
- If necessary, classes can work in the cooler hallways, the library or even the gym.

We remind families to ensure children have hats, sunscreen and wear light clothing daily to protect themselves from heat and UV rays.

## **Early Dismissal in Elementary Schools**
