PEANUT POLICY

Re: Peanut Allergies

We would like to thank you for your understanding and co-operation as a result of the request at the beginning of the year to avoid sending peanut and nut products to school. However, on occasion there have been a few food products that contain peanut allergens brought into the school. Even a minute amount of the allergic substance can cause a life-threatening reaction, keeping it out of the classroom and school is our best method of preventing a serious reaction at school. It is for this reason that we continue to ask for your co-operation in refraining from sending any peanut products and by-products to school. We hope that you will be able to support us in this regard to reduce the risk factor.



PEDICULOSIS

Pediculosis (head lice). Head lice are common in school-aged children. They are not considered to be a communicable disease and do not cause illness, however they are a nuisance and can spread easily. Anyone can get them.

The attached information sheet from the Canadian Pediatric Society contains more information about the identification, treatment and prevention of head lice. We encourage you to check your child's head. If your child has nits (eggs) and/or live lice, we request that you notify the school and apply treatment as soon as possible.

NEW FENCING

Over the March Break, the York Region District School Board installed "off set" fencing connected to the two street access points in the North East (primary) field. This initiative was a result of the concerns with student safety during our recess times. This fencing still allows access into the school yard and it is stroller accessible for all our community members who walk to school from the the North side.
