Driver behaviour has continued to be a challenge at the end of the day when students are being dismissed and we are VERY concerned about student, staff and parent safety at this time. We have had manage complaints about aggressive behaviour, students being waved through the parking lot traffic between cars and people parking cars in the middle of the lanes. Because people start parking in the lot at 2:45 it is not possible for staff to manage and supervise this area for free movement of the vehicles.

With the good weather we encourage your children to walk, bike or take the bus to and from school. If you must pick up your child please park along Legacy Avenue or Rouge Bank Drive (being mindful of the no stopping zones).

All schools in the York Region District School Board are committed to improving student achievement and well-being. On Thursday, June 29, 2017, an early release day will take place to allow elementary teachers and support staff to take part in meetings during the afternoon of that day. These meetings will allow for school staff to engage in culminating activities regarding the review and revision of the School's Improvement Plan as well as year-end and transition activities that support student success.

As has been our practice in the past, students will attend school during the morning of Thursday, June 29, 2017 only. Students will be dismissed early that day at 12:00p.m. Arrangements will be made to ensure that students who are normally bused to and from school will receive transportation at this time. Parents/guardians whose children attend after school child care should make appropriate arrangements to address this change in schedule.
