#### **Women Support Network Presentations**

#### Motorized screen and mounted projector for the gym / Auditorium

- A motorized screen for the gym which is used as an auditorium for staff professional developments, community engagement sessions, school assemblies, presentations and workshops.
- The screen will be embedded in the corner of the gym.
- LCD projector mounted from the ceiling will cost \$3870.25 projector.
- The school can purchase the projector with school funds
- Requesting support to fund the screen and labour cost for mounting the projector and screen from council
- Motorized screen will coast \$800.00
- Labour, Electrical work equals \$6200.00
- Total cost for the project is \$17, 900.00
- Total amount requested from school council = 50%
- Start with the projector purchase and work on the rest of the funds.
- Hoping that the move a- thon will cover the rest of the funds.
- School will also cover a percentage of the funds.
- School and council support will be 50 / 50 in cost sharing
- The cost sharing program from the school board has ceased to exist.
- The school can purchase the projector with our budge

### Snacks for any students who do not bring snacks

- Snacks are regularly provided to students who do not bring snacks or need extra snacks
- Requesting 300. 00 dollars for supplement to purchase some snacks to sustain till the end of school year and for september.
