- The following were suggested:
  - change voting members to 15 in order to be more inclusive of those who are interested in actively participating in School Council.
  - discussion to change notification process: notify elected members <u>before</u> the first council meeting; notify via email

Motion: to increase the voting members from 9 to 15

<u>Vote:</u> Yes: unanimous – all 8 members present voted Yes

Motion: to change the date of School Council election to be held before the first School Council meeting of the school year

Vote: Yes: unanimous – all 8 members present voted Yes
