Safety Procedures

- school parking lot was not plowed until after school today
- If a class can not be covered, a note/email will be sent home with students to inform parents of asynchronous learning from home for a particular day
- New preventions from public health :
- Before covid, classes would be dismissed to isolate if there was a positive case in the classroom. Now, school is no longer a high risk zone for transmission, and classmates will not be informed of covid cases in the classroom unless we reach a 30% absence rate
- 3 ply cloth masks are yet to arrive surgical masks will still be provided
- N95 masks are now provided for teachers and can be worn by teachers if they choose to
- School is in a good position to support online learning with technology if necessary
- Rapid tests will be handed out tomorrow from their homeroom teachers; students who are not physically at school will receive them shortly; 2 tests/student and are to be used if the child is symptomatic
