In lieu of office gifts we donate gift cards to families -We also have healthy snacks in office to provide to children who come to school with no snacks/lunches (individual bagged veggies/breadsticks)
	-Question from member: Can school accept winter gear for families in need? -Lorellie - Yes! Brand new gloves/hats can be sent with your children to donate. There wasn't a need in the beginning but the need is now being seen with kids who come to school with no winter items or the items have been outgrown
	-Question from member: Can we donate money online for winter gear through school cash online? -Lorellie will look into this

from Public Health, unless they show symptoms
-Families generally notify the school of a positive case
-Public Health is busy and it could take them 2 days to
notify the school of a positive case
-Question from member: Are we ready for online
learning with the rising cases?
