## Before You Apply

- 1. Choose 1-3 <u>Centennial College Programs</u> you want to apply for.

- 6. Contact your <u>Regional Admissions Team member</u> to check your application status (Include your student number, or name and date of birth in your email).
- 7. If you meet the admission requirements, you will receive an acceptance package. In order to secure a seat in your program, pay your registration deposit and tuition fees by the deadlines indicated on your offer letter. View <u>Payments Options</u>.
- 8. <u>Apply for a Study Permit/Visa</u> using your Centennial College offer letter, fee receipt and other documents required by Citizenship and Immigration Canada.
- 9. Notify your Admissions Team if your study permit application is approved.
- 10. Complete your registration in person upon arrival at the Centennial College International Centre (Hard copies of your original documents, passport and study permit are required).

## **Required Documents**

- For Post-Secondary Programs: High school transcripts and diplomas are required. For Maple High School Graduates, to receive a copy of your transcript that you will send to the colleges, please email <u>maria.carinci@yrdsb.ca</u> from your YRDSB GAPPS email account and include all information to be sent for verification purposes. For example, your OCAS Application Number, your OEN number, your Maple High School student number, your individualized College Application ID Number (if the college has given you one upon receipt of your application), the recipient's email address, the recipient's mailing address, the name of the person who the transcript is being sent to?
- Register and Complete <u>Academic English Proficiency</u> requirement (<u>IELTS</u>, <u>TOEFL</u>, or other programs accepted by Centennial).
- Please review the admissions requirements for your program on the online program outline; portfolio, letter of interest, resume, or online program information session may be required for your program.
- The first page of your passport (the page with your photo, if applicable)
- Check with the International Admissions Assistant for individual assistance.
