- Graduation Requirements: 30 Credits; Literacy test or Course; 40 Hours (see <http://www.yrdsb.ca/Programs/Guidance/CommunityInvolvement/Pages/default.aspx>)
- Credit Counselling Summary – make an appointment to check your graduation requirements status.
  - **Transmission of Marks to University & College** - All applications for Ontario colleges and universities are done on-line. In order to ensure that your demographic and grades information is available to the college and university application centres, we will use secure transmission technology to release the grades for all students in Grade 12 to the *Ontario College Application Service* and the *Ontario University Application Centre*. - Applying to College/University
  - **College** - applications start in October
    - Application fee - \$95 - five program choices
    - February 1/2020 – equal consideration date
  - **University** – applications start typically in mid November – once you receive PIN - Pin numbers sent to Guidance from OUAC. We will send them via your GAPPs account
    - Application fee - \$150 – three choices; \$50 each additional choice
    - January 15/2020 – application DEADLINE date
  - **Post-Secondary Application Workshops** – College – October 24 @ lunch in the Library
    - University Apps – October 25 @ lunch in the Library
  - **Supplementary Applications** – check the websites of the schools you apply to, to find out if the program requires a Supplementary Application to be completed – this is **your** responsibility
