OPEN FORUM DISCUSSION (All attendees)

- Principal Profile School Council would like to review the principal profile on an annual basis. Last year it wasn't completed by council. Council has requested to review it at the January 14th meeting. - STILL OUTSTANDING. Hema will forward council the profile from the previous chair from last year.
- **SIP information -** Council asked administration for an annual report to present at the June meeting on what has been completed for 2024/2025 on the schools improvement plan (SIP).
- Temperature Threshold When the temperature reaches -18c students have an indoor recess. At -17c or -16c students would have a shorter outdoor recess and have the remaining inside. Council will discuss the opportunity for a winter coat swap at a future meeting.
