2024/2025 GOALS & PRIORITIES (School staff)

- The school is interested in purchasing 3 projection systems at \$3000.00 each to upgrade technology in the classrooms
- Staff are looking for activities for students during indoor recess such as art supplies
- Staff are creating a STEM space in the library this year for students
- Currently selling cookies as a fundraiser to raise money for grade 6 musical instruments
 looking for more mouthpieces for instruments
- The school was able to secure more lunch monitors this year than last year
- Staff are interested in building upon mental health spaces for students in the classrooms

2024/2025 EVENT DISCUSSION (All attendees)

- 2 event dates scheduled for 2024/2025:

 - 2. Thursday April 10th: TBD
- Parent council is looking for volunteers to assist on the night of the event for set up, serving pizza, working the snack table and take-down

OPEN FORUM DISCUSSION (All attendees)

- Council is requesting that school staff explore an alternative, more affordable and flexible pizza program for the January term. The current food programs are all between \$8-10. The request is to offer a food option closer to last year's pricing at \$3 with flexible days
- Parents would like to see students attend more field trips this year
- Students would like to have softer balls to play with at recess
- Parent council members requested that the grade 4 students in the ¾ split classes have the same lunch recess as the other grade 4 class (located on the second floor). Hema informed parents that it is an issue with caretaking cleaning an additional classroom during the lunch hour as they do not report to the principal and cannot be directed by her.
- Parents brought up concerns about the birthday party invitation ban. The Principal
 clarified that invitations are still allowed to be sent by students to the school. The
 Principal will send a communication to all parents clarifying that invitations are still
 allowed to be sent to school, where students are permitted to hand them out and should
 do so discreetly, without teacher involvement. Students should always consider the
 feelings of others when handing out invitations, and parents are asked to reinforce this
 message at home.
- Council asked what types of clubs and special programs teachers would be interested in supporting for students this year. A survey will be sent out to students to gather feedback and interests.
- The bags from last year that parent council funded for each classroom with balls for recess need to be topped this year. Some were lost or damaged
