<u>PEERS Program for Students with Autism</u>

This January, in YRDSB, there is an exciting opportunity for students with Autism! We will be offering students the opportunity to participate in an evidence based social skills program called Program for the Education and Enrichment of Relationship Skills (PEERS®) The PEERS® program engages students in 16 different modules that teach teens social skills that focus on making and keeping friends. The program will be running VIR-TUALLY for sixteen weeks, from the weeks of January 16th - May 8th, on Tuesday, Wednesday OR Thursday evenings from 4-6pm.

In order for the PEERs curriculum to meet the needs of all students in the group it is important the recommended students meet the criteria listed below:

• Students in grades 7-11 who are working at, or close to, grade level curriculum (Locally Developed/Applied/Academic)

- Students who are socially motivated and are wanting to develop social skills or improve their social skills, (they have to want to join a social skills group)
- Students who are looking for next steps in their social understanding (currently struggling with higher level, adolescent/teen social skills and innuendo)
- Students who have same age friends/peers but are finding it increasingly difficult to "fit in"
- Students who are interested in meeting other students who may share similar interests to them

<u>Tutoring Support Programs</u>

As a part of the Province's efforts to support learning in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, additional funding has been allocated for the first term of the 2022-23 school year (**ending on December 15, 2022**) for Tutoring Support Programs.

Project funding will provide small group tutoring support for students. The purpose of this funding is to offer programs that will support learning recovery and renewal in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. YRDSB has included an opportunity to partner with community organizations who can provide tutoring supports to students. These tutoring programs will prioritize math, literacy and other foundational learning skills and are intended to promote learning recovery and to help address achievement and skills development gaps. In addition, these programs will support learning in a trusted environment grounded in the language, culture and community norms for students.
