

Message from the Business Department

The University of Waterloo is once again hosting the Financial Literacy Competition. The contest runs every December and May and is open to all high school students. It is divided into two divisions - junior (grades 9 and 10) and senior (grades 11 and 12). Students will be given a series of questions to answer in a timed format. The University provides resources to help students prepare for the competition. In the past, two grand prizes of \$750 were awarded to the top students in both the junior and senior division. This amount was contributed to the student's RESP. In addition, recognition was also given to the top finalists as well as certificate of achievements to all eligible students. Students who are competing for the first time are eligible for the awards. Students who have competed in the past at the junior level (grade 9 or 10) are eligible to compete in the senior level and are also eligible for awards and recognition. Mrs. Lovell will be holding weekly training sessions beginning in November to help students prepare for the contest. Details will be communicated at a later date once the University of Waterloo has finalized the details for this year's competition. -Ms. Lovell
