Do You PUDO at MDHS?

What's PUDO? It stands for **Pick-Up and Drop-Off**. Our school has a designated Pick-Up and Drop-Off area in the west parking area. If you're dropping off or picking up your child, please use the PUDO marked loop around the parking area. Do not use the main lane to drop off your child; this impedes traffic flow. After dropping off your child, please exit by following the loop to either of the two exits on Church Street. Do not exit through the parking area laneways.

Please also note that the PUDO is intended for immediate use. After dropping off your child, you must exit once it is safe. Families have received tickets (\$200) for waiting in the PUDO (e.g., when staying in the PUDO to pick up their child). Please use the parking area if you need to wait for your child.

Indigenous Languages and International Languages - Secondary Credit Programs

Dear Students and Families,

We welcome everyone to the 2022-2023 Indigenous Languages and International Languages (ILIL) program year and thank you for your continued support and patience.

During the pandemic, enrolment in the ILIL Credit program grew when compared to previous years. As a result, the program will remain in an online (remote) format. The program will be delivered virtually through synchronous learning, supported by asynchronous activities. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language classes. All program updates will be made on our Board ILIL program homepage.

Did you know there are many benefits to taking credit language courses?

- Students can take one International Languages Course as a Group 1 Compulsory or as an Elective Credit towards their Ontario Secondary Diploma.
- Students in the Secondary International Languages program can earn up to three credits towards graduation.
- If students earn a credit in the Level D (university) course, it can be used as one of their top six (6) marks for post-secondary entry. For example, if a student takes Spanish Level B, C and D, the student can submit their Level D mark as one of the top six marks for post-secondary applications.
