What's Happening In the Tech Department

TIJ 1O - Grade 9 Exploring Technologies

The boxes that students have been working hard on will begin to be assembled. Students will mark the location for their finishing nails and hammer them in until they just break the surface. They will use these to align them to their corresponding piece to ensure a clean edge before applying glue which will provide further structure to their boxes. Once all sides have been assembled they will begin the process of cleaning up the exterior of the box working with progressively finer sandpaper until they have a finished surface.



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TXJ2O - Grade 10 Hairstyling and Aesthetics

After completing a research assignment which required students to learn about different cultural approaches to beauty, students will now be putting their learning into practice. Using face charts they will plan a look which reflects the beauty standards of the culture they have studied. Once the planning stage is complete they will begin the process of using actual beauty products on their practice mannequin to achieve the desired look.

TDJ 3M - Grade 11 Tech Design

Having constructed both a detailed Foyer and Living Room in AutoCAD students will turn their attention to the requirements of planning out a Kitchen space. Learning will focus on improving their working with AutoCAD in constructing their designs, the variety of layouts of kitchen spaces and their ergonomic requirements.

TCJ4C - Grade 12 Construction

Students of Grade 12 Construction are putting finishing touches on their build projects. Students have produced a number of spectacular items which fit their interests/needs and allowed them to demonstrate their meeting course expectations. As we round out the semester they will be engaging in a project which will allow them to gain hands-on experience in a project which will touch on such trades as framing, dry-walling, plumbing, electrical, and carpentry.

MDHS Feeder School STEM Outreach

Next week our Tech Department will be visiting William Armstrong Public School to kick off of our new pilot program. Students in Grade 7 and 8 will create 3D printed models and learn how to code programs in Scratch to create a cross-curricular project utilizing the engineering design process.
