

Welcome to the YRDSB Family Dashboard

The dashboard will give you secure one-stop access to information and applications related to your child's education. It is designed to make it easier for you to engage with your child's education.

Register today at family.yrdsb.ca.

Setting up your account

- 1. Visit family.yrdsb.ca.
- 2. Click "No account? Create one" under the email.
- 3. Enter the email address you have on file at your child's school, and click the Next Button.
- Check your email, you will receive an email with a one-time code that expires within 30 minutes in order to confirm your identity. Enter that code on the account creation screen.

Once your email has been validated you will be asked to:

1. Create a password.

Passwords must be between 8-256 characters and include three of the four following types of characters: lowercase characters; uppercase characters, numbers (0-9); symbols

- 2. Enter a Display Name (your parent/guardian name).
- Enter the following information about your child or one of your children for further verification:

If you use the same email address for your children's schools, all of your children will show in the dashboard once you have registered.

- a. Student Number (is the same number as their GAPPS ID, or is available in EDBSY)
- b. Student Birthdate
- c. Student Home Address Postal Code

In 2025, NACCA will award scholarships to up to **11 students**, providing them with financial support as they pursue their educational goals. Below are the available scholarship categories: Please encourage your students to apply as soon as possible, NACCA is accepting applications for various scholarships until **March 31, 2025**.

Scholarship Categories & Awards:

- 1. NACCA General Scholarship \$1,500 each
 - a. Awarded to students demonstrating academic achievement and community involvement.
 - b. If five students are selected, four will receive \$1,500 each, and one outstanding student will receive the **Iris Malcolm Memorial Award** instead (not both).

2. Iris Malcolm Memorial Award - \$2,500

- a. Given to one student who has demonstrated resilience by overcoming significant setbacks while excelling academically and in community service.
- 3. Southlake Regional Health Centre Scholarship \$2,500 each **New for 2025
 - a. Awarded to **four students** entering health-related fields such as medicine, nursing, public health, or other healthcare disciplines.
- 4. Rightsline Computer Science Scholarship \$5,000 per year (for four years) + Internship **New for 2025
 - a. Awarded to a student pursuing computer science, technology, or a related field.
 - b. This four-year renewable scholarship includes an internship component, providing both financial support and hands-on industry experience.
 - c. Students applying for this scholarship must submit an essay (see terms and conditions).
- 5. Wasim Jarrah Business Excellence Award \$750 each
 - a. Awarded to **two graduating students** who have demonstrated excellence in business and entrepreneurship studies.
 - b. Open to NACCA Scholarship recipients graduating from a **York Region secondary school** and pursuing business.
 - c. A student entering business has the opportunity to earn a **total of \$2,250 in scholarships** (\$1,500 NACCA Scholarship + \$750 Wasim Jarrah Award).
