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Message form our Technology Department

TIJ10 - Grade 9 Exploring Technologies

Students will be reading electrical schematics and using Tinkercad to simulate circuits before building physical projects. The projects will be a police siren and motorcycle engine sound circuit before leading up to utilizing a 555 integrated circuit timer to control blinking lights.

TXJ2O - Grade 10 Hairstyling and Aesthetics

Students will be working with learning mannequins and a variety of other tools (bobby pins, padded brushes, teasing brushes, etc.) as they learn the steps required to to create an updo. Each student will be dividing the hair of their mannequin into different sections to create a French Twist at the back and have the option of choosing from previously demonstrated styling methods to create their finished updo.

TGJ3M1 - Grade 11 Comm Tech

Grade 11 Comm Tech students are working on their Motion Graphics assignment. Using Adobe After Effects they are tasked with generating emotionally driven Title Sequences like those at the beginning blockbuster films.

TEL3M/TEL4M - Grade 11/12 Computer Technology (Electronics/Robotics)

The Computer Technology students have begun their soldering projects. TEL3M1 (Gr.11) are soldering the control circuits to control the LED's for miniature traffic lights. TEL4M1 (Gr.12) are soldering game circuits for either a digital dice or roulette wheel.
