MARKHAM VILLAGE STORM SEWER UPGRADE PROJECT (PHASE 1A) INTERSCETION CLOUSURE NOTICE- CHURCH ST - WOOTEN WAY N

Dear Resident,

We are pleased to inform you that the first phase (Phase 1A) of the Markham Village Storm Sewer Upgrade Project is now underway. This phase focuses on upgrading the existing storm sewers along Church Street.

As work progresses towards 9th Line, the intersection of Church Street and Wooten Way North will be closed from October 21, 2024, to October 26, 2024. During this period, alternative routes will be available as follows:

- For residents north of the intersection: Access to Church Street will be via Parkway Avenue, Sir Galahad Place, and Sir Isaac Gate.
- For residents east and south of the intersection: Access to Church Street will be via Linden Lea Street, Reesorville Road, and Newton Gate.
- Access from Elm Street will remain available at all times.

Please refer to the attached traffic detour plan for further details.

The City of Markham, in collaboration with the contractor (Drainstar), is working diligently to minimize disruptions and complete these essential infrastructure upgrades as efficiently as possible.


