- a) **Traffic Observations Dec 4, 2018 –** observe traffic incoming and outgoing by Peter, Tina and Robert in both East and West parking lots Robert made a chart comparing findings from 2015 2018
 - a. Morning student drop offs on North and South side of Church same findings
 - b. Jay Walking 21 in 2018 (no #'s from 2015)
 - c. Vehicle violations (ie. Uturns) -2015 (many) -2018 -(2)
 - d. Driving down aisles in West lot and "budding" into exit lanes 2015 (many) 2018 (3)
 - double exit lane in West lot has helped less drop off directly on Church and the "Pick up/Drop off" (PUDO) is being used more
 - cones at the end of aisles worked well but require manpower to put them out suggestion put forth to put signs at end of aisles ie. "Do Not Enter"
