- Mental Health
 - Admin will circle back with School Council to review and discuss presentations
- Picture Day
 - o Grade 9 and 11 students pictures taken today for yearbook and ID card
 - o Tomorrow Grade 10 and 12 stduent pictures
 - No make-up dates
 - Grad photos to be taken in January
- Community involvement month
 - Noticing students completing volunteer work but not submitting forms for volunteer hours
- Peer mentors
 - During lunch and after school
 - Will create holiday cards
 - o Looking to give cards to Markhaven or MSH
- Grade 8 Open House- Dec 2nd
 - Videos to be viewed by students and parents
 - Q&A sessions via Zoom
- o OSSLT
 - Approximately 314 students that wrote test (Grade 11's)
 - Grade 10's will be writing in Spring
 - New system which is online
 - Students finished quicker than anticipated
 - Students cannot cheat; every screen is different; questions in different sequence
 - Administration of test easier now that it's online

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- o Mid-Term Report Cards
 - Marks provided on Teach Assist
 - Nov 25-30th- Marks to be updated and reported on transcript
 - Students can write this test more than once; mark is not shared; just a checkmark shows on their transcript as a requirement for their OSSD
- o YRDSB Ministry Announcements
 - o Students coming to school expected to self-screen
 - Potential model change for Semester 2; board is working with public health; expect announcement soon regarding a full-period day
 - o Could start prior to next semester
- o Exams
 - Won't have traditional exams for Semester 1 but instead will have a summative
- School Activities
 - Lots of clubs and activities
 - Volleball, basketball, hockey, volleyball, many clubs
 - Students must be vaccinated to participate
- Inclement weather day
 - o Track announcements on board website
 - Will be asynchronous day if declare inclement weather day
