APPOINTMENTS

As of Wednesday, September 20th, students can begin making appointments online using Teach Assist.

- Have your child log in to their Teach Assist account
- Under the sub-heading "Appointment Bookings"
- Click on the day and time the student wants to have their appointment (if the appointment slot is highlighted in blue). If there are no appointments displayed, then you will have to select another day, as all counsellors have been booked for that day.
- You will see shaded in blue "All open appointments". Choose the appropriate alpha Guidance counsellor (based on your child's last name) from the list on the left.
- If the student needs to cancel their appointment for any reason, click "cancel".

Community Involvement/Volunteering

The community involvement graduation requirement is a minimum of 40 hours.

The ministry is updating the Community Involvement Graduation Requirement policy. Community involvement is an important educational opportunity that allows students to develop skills and gain experiences to become successful and contributing members of society now and in the future.

Therefore, there will no longer be any hours used for work or any hours done in the home.

Here are the steps you must follow in order to ensure your hours are approved:

- Step 1: Review the list of eligible activities as set out on the YRDSB website.
- Step 2: Select an activity. Students may want to contact one or more of the following charitable organizations; community agencies · community centers · government offices · service clubs · volunteer centers Contact your guidance counsellor if you are unsure if your activity will count. In the event that you do not discuss the volunteer activity with your guidance counsellor, then you run the risk of your hours not counting.
- Step 4: Complete your volunteer activities
- Step 5: Submit the completed form. Ensure that all sections are completed, including parent signature, supervisor name, title and contact details. Then submit the completed form to Guidance.



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Night School

Semester 1 Night School 2023-2024

There are two night school formats (each with their own course offerings)

Remote Learning "SYNCHRONOUS"

Semester One - Fall 2023: Classes: October 5, 2023 to February 1, 2024

- The program will be delivered virtually in real-time (synchronous).
- Classes are on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, 6:30-9:45 p.m.
- Before the start of the program, students will receive an email with instructions on how to join the class on the first day logging in with their gapps account.
- *Decisions to run courses are based on student enrollment and teacher availability.
- Students should discuss this with their alpha counselor to ensure eligibility. Students register online on My Pathway Planner.

If a student registers, they MUST inform their counselor to ensure that approval is granted.
