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COURSE SELECTION VERIFICATIONS

Course selection verifications for the 2024-25 school year were sent to students' gapps emails on Monday, March 25.

Carefully review your course requests for accuracy. If you notice any errors or require changes be sure to:

- 1) Print the verification form.
- 2) Cross out the course(s) you wish to change.
- 3) Neatly print the new course(s) you wish to add.
- 4) Have your parent/guardian sign and date the verification form.
- 5) Submit your signed form to the Guidance office no later than TUESDAY, APRIL 2nd.

Please keep in mind that this is the <u>last</u> chance to make any changes to your requested courses before the timetabling process begins. We will make every effort to provide students with a school timetable that matches their original requests. Alternate courses, however, may need to be used in order to resolve scheduling conflicts.

REQUESTS FOR DOCUMENTS

The Guidance office has been getting numerous requests for copies of report cards and proof of enrollment documents.

Please note that it is the student's responsibility to download/print all report cards when they received access to the link.

If you require proof of enrollment documents, or similar, please provide the Guidance office with a copy of the request from the organization (ie. Canada Revenue Agency). The Guidance office requires a minimum of 2—3 days to prepare documents once the request has been made.





Summer School

Summer school registration is scheduled to open on April 9th in myBlueprint.

Acceleration Courses (18 days)

- For students who wish to earn a credit in a subject they have not previously studied or those who wish to upgrade a mark in a course that they have successfully completed.
- Students are encouraged to register early to avoid disappointment.
- Course offerings are not guaranteed as they are based on enrollment and teacher availability.
- Students can only take **one** acceleration course during the summer session.
- Transportation is **not** provided for this program.

Online Learning

- Courses that are specifically designed to be taught in a fully online format.
- Online learning does not require pupils and teachers to be face-to-face with each other.
- Classes occur online using an asynchronous model, with check-in opportunities with the teacher.
- The learning platform is Brightspace by D2L.
- Dates: Tuesday, July 2 to Thursday, July 25

Hours: Flexible (6 hours per day minimum)

In-Person Learning

- Courses will be offered in a face-to-face learning model.
 - Dates: Wednesday, July 3 to Friday, July 26
 - Hours: 8:45 am to 3:33 pm

STUDENTS 18+ YEARS OF AGE

AGE OF CONSENT FORM

When a child turns 18, they are legally considered an adult. With this change, ALL communication from the school, regarding your child will cease, AUTOMATICALLY, unless your child has completed, signed, and returned the Age of Consent Form. This form can be obtained from the Attendance Office. Failure to do so will mean that you will not receive ANY information from the school anymore including, but not limited to: information about your child's attendance and achievement, information about school closures, changes to the timetable or schedule, any information about Graduation (including the date and web address). It is imperative that if your child has turned 18 or will turn 18 before the end of this school year, they need to complete the Age of Consent Form. Teachers, Administration, and the school as a whole are unable to share any information with you if this has not been completed. The completed form is to be returned to the Main Office.
