COURSE SELECTION VERIFICATION — CHANGE REQUEST

The form to request a change to a student's course selections was sent out today, **Friday, April 1st.** Please check your gapps account for further instructions and to access the form.

If changes are requested, the form must be submitted no later than **Friday, April 8th at 3:00 pm**.

Once this process is closed, you will not be able to request a change to your courses until September 2022. If your child will be attending SVS next year, this process does not apply to you.

VOLUNTEER HOURS

Planning to graduate in June 2022? The community involvement graduation requirement for 2021-2022 has been reduced to a minimum of **20 hours** of community involvement activities. We have many potential graduates who are missing some or all of their community involvement hours.

NOTE: Students who are attending school (face-to-face) are to drop off their volunteer hour forms in person to the Guidance Office.

AGE OF CONSENT FORM

When a child turns 18, they are legally considered an adult. With this change, ALL communication from the school, regarding your child will cease, AUTOMATICALLY, unless your child has completed, signed, and returned the Age of Consent Form. **This form can be obtained from the Attendance Office.**

Failure to do so will mean that you will not receive **ANY** information from the school anymore including, but not limited to: information about your child's attendance and achievement, information about school closures, changes to the timetable or schedule, any information about Graduation (including the date and web address).

It is imperative that if your child has turned 18 or will turn 18 before the end of this school year, they need to complete the Age of Consent Form. Teachers, Administration, and the school as a whole are unable to share any information with you if this has not been completed. The completed form is to be returned to the **Main Office**.

Summer School / Spring Dual Credit

SUMMER SCHOOL / E-LEARNING SUMMER SCHOOL

We recognize that there is strong interest in summer school courses for 2022.

Once registration opens we will share the available course options, the process for registering for courses and if necessary, the process for replacing a course in your child's course selections for next school year as a result of a summer school registration.

REGISTRATION FOR SPRING DUAL CREDIT COURSES

Most courses start the week of April 25th and run until the week of June 6th. Most courses are 2 x / week; approx. 8 hours/week).

Things to consider:

- ⇒ Semester 2 dual credit courses will ALL be offered using an ONLINE delivery model unless otherwise noted.
- ⇒ In-Person— courses currently require students to be vaccinated as per the requirements of the college (that may change)
- ⇒ It is CRITICAL that you have technology and WiFi access to complete these dual credit courses. You will need to check your gapps account regularly for information for course information.
- ⇒ While most of your course will run asynchronously, courses will have a live component that you should attend if your high school timetable allows it. These live sessions will be recorded. There will be TWO synchronous sessions each week.
- ⇒ You **must** log in regularly and be able to commit to the **minimum** times set out by the college instructor.
