- 2. Which courses are required in Grade 12 to apply to an Ontario **University?** To an Ontario College?
  - University Degree applicants require a minimum of SIX Gr 12 courses (ENG4U1 + five courses ending in 4U1 or 4M1,
  - including prerequisites). Course prerequisites/requirements for University entrance vary depending upon the program.
  - College Diploma applicants require Gr 12 English (4C or 4U) and completion of the OSSD. There may be additional courses
